for Improved Cookstove Training Services

Renewable World (RW) is a not-for-profit international development organisation that aims to alleviate poverty through access to clean, reliable renewable energy. We specialise in developing and deploying effective ways of bringing off-grid renewable energy solutions to the most remote and underserved communities, empowering them to achieve sustainable and resilient lives.

RW will be implementing *Renewable Energy for Change (RE4C)* project in four districts in West Nepal i.e. Surkhet, Salyan, Banke and Accham to improve the livelihoods of rural communities through different renewable energy technologies (RETs). One of the RETs that RW proposes to promote through this project is the 'Improved Cookstove'. RW plans to promote appropriate type of Improved Cookstove in Surkhet and Salyan Districts for which we are seeking a consultant/consulting services. Specially, we plan to deliver the following activities: Improved Cookstove needs assessment, training, installation and follow-up work, targeting six communities between September 2020 and March 2021, followed by a further 14 communities between April 2021 and December 2021.
