About us

Renewable World is an international charity that tackles poverty through the provision of affordable renewable energy. By connecting remote communities with clean energy, and training them to use it productively, our projects work to support; income generation, sustainable livelihoods, reduction in health problems, access to light for children's education; and ultimately provide power people to support individuals to work their way out of poverty.

Role summary

RW is currently undertaking research into Renewable Energy projects in Kenya to support our programme development. We are looking for a researcher to support our work and gather data on Renewable Energy projects, what other INGOs and NGOs are doing to support Renewable Energy access, and donor trends within this region. Your primary responsibility will be to work with RW staff and partners to undertake desk based research to support our wider data capture plan within our programme development process for Kenya.

During Covid-19 this post will be based at home with regular meetings using online technology (Skype and Zoom primarily). We ask for a regular commitment of at least 2 days per week for a minimum period of 3 months. Our standard working hours are 9am - 5:30pm, though we can be flexible to suit individuals needs. This position is unpaid; however, we do offer a daily stipend of £10.

Responsibilities:

- To research Bilateral/ government donors working within Kenya and East Africa and create a data set of information highlighting donor priorities surrounding Renewable Energy Access.
- To research INGOs and NGOs within Kenya and create a database showcasing current Renewable Energy projects within Kenya (with a specific focus on the Lake Victoria region)
- To research thought leaders, academic institutions and think tanks and share information on how organisations are undertaking advocacy and Renewable Energy Access within Kenya
